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#### **Brief summary of Respondent's background and relevant experience:**

Energie Bellator Inc. is a Quebec company, financially seeded by BP Energy as a Green Energy Marketing Company that works with Green Energy producers across Eastern Canada and Upstate New York.

Chris Anderson, the founder and CEO, worked as CEO of Hydro-Quebec's commercial operations for 10 years, reengineered its commercial operations, designed and built of a world class trading room, hired and trained over 100 commercial professionals and built Hydro-Quebec energy services into one of the largest energy traders in North America. A change in government in Quebec, at the same time as the credit crisis created by Enron, ended Hydro-Quebec involvement in transactions south of the Canadian border.

#### **Energie Bellator's Mission:**

To purchase and aggregate Green Energy from producers of biomass, wind, solar and low impact hydro in Upstate New York (including BP Wind), Ontario, Quebec and the Maritime Provinces across the Hydro-Quebec transmission grid into the Champlain-Hudson Power Express project for ultimate delivery to the Greater New York City area.

#### **Energie Bellator Business:**

By aggregating multiple suppliers, Energie Bellator will provide a competitive, diverse supplier mix that will also have Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) assigned to the energy and capacity so

as to help the State of New York and NYSERDA meet its Renewable Portfolio Standard obligations.

Energie Bellator Inc. is “First in the Queue” with its firm transmission reservation across Hydro-Quebec’s transmission system with the firm delivery point of Champlain-Hudson Power Express. This transmission reservation is for 43 years and is cosigned by BP Energy. As Hydro-Quebec Production Company has a U.S. power marketing license, Hydro-Quebec’s transmission company has the same transmission tariff regime as U.S. power transmission companies. Champlain-Hudson Power Express, owned by Transmission Developers Inc. (“T.D.I.”), will be a merchant transmission line, however, F.E.R.C has obligated T.D.I. that a minimum of 25% of the line capacity will be bid in an “Open Season” process. Energie Bellator will be the winner in the Open Season process as it is “First in the Queue” in upstream transmission, has the financial support of BP Energy, along with Renewable Energy Credits.

Energie Bellator is working closely with the Province of Ontario to ensure that Ontario realizes financial value for its Renewable Energy Credits as Ontario has become one of the greenest jurisdictions in the world due to its 2008 legislation of the Green Energy Act.

Energie Bellator is working closely with a number of environmental groups in Quebec, such as, Foundation Rivière, Ottawa River Keepers, New York River Keepers, and Chercher le Courant that support low impact green energy production.
